It is the policy of the Toronto Police Services Board that:

1. The Chief of Police will ensure that the Service will provide the services of a public order unit by using Service members, and that it will consist of a unit supervisor and at least four squads of seven officers, including the squad leader for undertaking public order activities;
2. The Chief of Police will ensure that public order services are deployed in a reasonable time;
3. The Chief of Police will ensure that the established procedures set out the circumstances in which the public order unit services may be deployed;
4. The Chief of Police will develop and maintain a manual on public order unit services that is available to each Service member providing these services; and
5. The Chief of Police will ensure that the members of the Public Order Unit have the appropriate knowledge, skills and abilities to provide the services of the Public Order Unit.
