I am a 73-year-old Jewish male who was born in Toronto. I have never had any reason to fear for being Jewish until now.

I have personal experiences in being afraid for my well-being, both at the overpass at Avenue Rd and Highway 401 when the Palestinian demonstrators were closing the roads and demonstrating angrily and loudly and threatening Lee.

I had an even worse experience at the University of Toronto when the 10th city was there, and I was stopped and harassed when I tried to pass by.

I was a palled, that these illegal and threatening incidents could happen in my own city, with no protection or involvement of the police force whatsoever that I could see.

Hate speech, such as "kill the Jews "was being made directly in front of police officers, who had no reaction and did not take any action against the perpetrators of hate speech and violent threats.

I resent the legality of these actions and the inactivity, in action and lack of response from our police force to protect us from these hostile and threatening forces.
