Leadership

- We need strong(er) and decisive leadership at all government levels to help combat hate.
- Any person responsible for educating children, adolescents, teen-agers and young adults must, by all means necessary use their position to sensitize and educate; promote tolerance and acceptance.
- TPS needs more funding and more officers sensitized to diverse cultures and beliefs.

Protests & Demonstrations

- Everyone, without exception should have the right to a peaceful demonstration and/or protest, <u>and only within a designated area</u>. For example: City Hall, Government offices, Queens' Park and embassies.
- What we've seen in the last few years and particularly post Oct 7 <u>have nothing to</u> <u>do</u> with peaceful protests.
- The Jewish community has been subject to hostilities, hate, slander, intimidation and violence.
- Hate speech of any kind and directed to ANY community must not be tolerated.
 Zero tolerance.

Laws

- Ban all face coverings at all demonstrations/protests.
- Adequately define the difference between free speech and hate speech.
- Define and impose **consequences** for anyone who engages in hate speech, slander, intimidation and/or violence. This includes property damage (defacing of walls and buildings, hate graffiti, road/bridge/overpass blockages etc.)
