It is the policy of the Toronto Police Services Board that:

1. The Chief of Police will develop and maintain procedures on the processes for undertaking and managing investigations into elder abuse and vulnerable adult abuse; and
2. The Chief of Police, where possible, work in partnership with the local Crown, municipalities, community and social service agencies/providers, businesses, seniors' and other local agencies to develop programs for preventing and responding to complaints of elder and vulnerable adult abuse, including fraud awareness and prevention.
