DERIVATION	Adequacy Standards Regulation - PO-001	

It is the policy of the Toronto Police Services Board that:

- 1. The Chief of Police will ensure that the Service will provide the services of a public order unit by using Service members, and that it will consist of a unit supervisor and at least four squads of seven officers, including the squad leader for undertaking public order activities;
- 2. The Chief of Police will ensure that public order services are deployed in a reasonable time;
- 3. The Chief of Police will ensure that the established procedures set out the circumstances in which the public order unit services may be deployed;
- 4. The Chief of Police will develop and maintain a manual on public order unit services that is available to each Service member providing these services; and
- 5. The Chief of Police will ensure that the members of the Public Order Unit have the appropriate knowledge, skills and abilities to provide the services of the Public Order Unit.
