DERIVATION	Adequacy Standards Regulation - ER-008	

It is the policy of the Toronto Police Services Board that:

- 1. The Chief of Police will prepare an emergency plan, consistent with the Adequacy Standards Regulation that;
 - a. establishes procedures and processes to be followed during an emergency;
 - b. the Chief of Police may adopt, in whole or part any of the City of Toronto's Emergency Plan provided it addresses the role, duties, procedures and processes of the Service during an emergency; and
 - c. establishes procedures with respect to counter-terrorism that are consistent with any federal and provincial counter-terrorism plan designated by the Solicitor General.
