<b>DERIVATION</b>	Adequacy Standards Regulation - LE-003	

It is the policy of the Toronto Police Services Board that:

1. The Chief of Police will ensure that the Service will provide crime, call and public disorder analysis by using Service members;
2. The Chief of Police will ensure that the Service may obtain the services of a crime analysis specialist, as required, who is not a Service member to assist with crime, call and public disorder analysis and who must be under the direction of a Service member;
3. The Chief of Police will establish procedures and processes for crime, call and public disorder analysis; and
4. The Chief of Police will share crime, call and public disorder analysis data and information on crime trends, as included in the Annual Report, with City Council, school boards, community organizations and groups, businesses and members of the public including Service members.
