**The undersigned, request that the Novotel hotel located at 45 The Esplanade, which is currently operating as a temporary homeless shelter until December 31, 2021, close on that date without any extension.**

The historic St. Lawrence neighborhood which forms part of Old Town Toronto has been transformed during the years into a SAFE and quiet tree lined architecturally significant stretch of residential street with condos, adjacent public and co-op housing and an enclave of landscaped terrace restaurants; this is a tourist attracting treasure – for the benefit of residents and visitors alike. It is located within close proximity to the financial district and sporting and theatre venues; the City of Toronto parking lot behind the Novotel is used by people working in the financial district and those accessing the sporting and theatre venues.



The introduction of the homeless shelter into this idyllic neighborhood has transformed it into an open-air, paraphernalia littered, drug market of dealers and users and a hotbed of the property and personal and quality of life crimes that are associated with it. Its neighbors feel, and are, unsafe with this shelter in its midst.

**The Esplanade neighborhood must be returned to what it was.**

### **February 19, 2021**

- 1 Esplanade, Robbery of storage lockers, taking peoples valuable personal property.

### **February 22, 2021**

- Union Station is no longer safe. Entered off York Street, lower level. In between the vestibule and the doorways homeless people sleeping and smoking. One set of doors were unusable because they were blocking them. Ordering dinner a homeless man walked without a mask right up to the front of the restaurant and proceeded to open the fridge and take out food items then was harassing customers for money. Staff told him to leave because he had no mask on and he started screaming at the staff and yelling obscenities and quoting biblical scripture. Staff called security who never arrived and the guy took off. Where was security?? Never going back to those restaurants at Union Station.

### **February 26, 2021**

- Suspicious person seen walking around our underground parking was ushered out by security.

### **February 28, 2021**

- Slashed tires on two cars on the P2 level. With all this security next door how is this happening?
- More needles found at St. James Park near the playground. Called Community Safety Team to report, said they would send someone out and the person on the phone had no idea where St. James Park & playground were?? Shouldn't they know this??
- Shoppers Drug Mart Lower Jarvis, police called multiple times, numerous unfriendly people in the store from the nearby shelter. Previously at the same store police were called a homeless man hit the security guard.
- Robbery at Princess and The Esplanade 6pm.
- Man pinned down outside of No Frills on Front Street, cops arrived. 7pm
- Security from 45 The Esplanade seen on the corner of Church and The Esplanade hanging out talking. Walked by them 3 times and they never moved. Also seen on their phones multiple times doing nothing. This is not what they are hired for!!

### **March 01, 2021**

- 2am I witnessed out my window. Orange cones were placed on Scott street to prevent parking. Car was sitting there with flashers watching the situation a homeless man came walking down Scott Street approached the car and leaned his head in I would assume to ask for money. When he was refused he huffed away and started kicking the cones at the car and at that point the guy in the car got out and watched the guy walk east on The Esplanade. He then proceeded to pick up the cones and put them back.

Update oreported needles above. Needles were still there despite calling!!

- Witness homeless man out in front of 45 The Esplanade yelling and screaming at everyone going by. Security guard just feet away and did nothing to try and calm the situation. (This is going to be amazing for businesses with the spring coming and outdoor patios being set up)

**March 08, 2021**

- Homeless tent set up on Yonge Street right in front of the Victoria Hotel which is a homeless shelter!! Makes NO sense. (Picture below)
- Bank entrance on Yonge Street!! (Picture below)

**March 09, 2021**

- Robbery at the Clutch Market on The Esplanade. Police were called.

These are all the incidents that I know of but I'm sure there are plenty more.

We used to have a nice quiet neighborhood before the shelter at 98 The Esplanade arrived. Ever since we have had more problems than we ever had. I use to feel safe day or night but I don't anymore and that's a very sad situation.

**March 10, 2021**

- Cigarette butts thrown all over the ground on the Esplanade.
- Needles found all over and not being cleaned up even after calls have been made.
- Homeless aggressively approaching multiple people in our neighborhood in several occasions including seniors and young families.

**March 11, 2021**

- Woman sleeping on the ledge at the driveway next to 45 The Esplanade
- Robbery at the LCBO at Front and Market Street
- Homeless man aggressively harassing people at NoFrills in Front Street then went on to scream at people in the Pet Value store and kept walking on Front Street screaming at everyone he approached and people at the gas station, corner of Front and Sherbourne.
- Homeless man sleeping outside The Old Spaghetti Factory door which is right across the street from the shelter at 45 The Esplanade!!

**March 16, 2021**

- Homeless man in Berczy Park trying to set the grass and trees on fire, when that didn't work he set a construction dumpster on fire near the park in Wellington. Multiple fire trucks arrived.

**March 17, 2021**

- Scott street fire truck, ambulance and about 6-8 cop cars. Arresting a homeless man down the alley along condo at 1 Scott Street. Apparently he was the person who set the fire the day before at Berczy Park!!!!

**Appendix "A"**  
**Major Terms and Conditions**

Landlord: Silver Hotels (Vancouver) Ltd.

Premises: The City will lease a minimum of 205 rooms, up to a maximum of 254 room units in the Hotel, along with the option to lease two boardrooms on the second floor of the hotel at 45 The Esplanade, Toronto.

Room Commitment: A minimum of 205 rooms, with the option for the City to increase the number of rooms required by the City up to a maximum of 254 rooms upon 7 days' prior written notice to the Landlord. In the event that the City exercises this option to increase the number of rooms leased, the City shall also have the right to subsequently decrease the number of rooms leased, upon 7 days' prior written notice to the Landlord; provided that in no event will the number of rooms leased be less than 205. Additionally, the City has the option to lease 2 boardrooms, on an as needed basis, upon 7 days' prior written notice to the Landlord.

Gross Rent: \$20,500.00 (plus HST) per day assuming 205 rooms and up to \$25,400.00 (plus HST) per day if 254 rooms are leased. At the City's discretion, the City may lease up to 2 boardrooms for \$80/day/boardroom (plus HST), which fee will be waived during any period of time that the City leases 254 rooms. Gross rent includes an apportionment of realty taxes. The City reserves the right to seek tax relief for the portion of realty tax attributed in the gross rent.

Additional Costs: All applicable HST.

Term: Ten (10) months and thirteen (13) days, commencing on February 16, 2021 until December 31, 2021 provided that the City has secured approval from Toronto Fire Services ("**TFS**") that the Premises is acceptable to the City for occupancy. In the event that TFS approval is not secured by February 16, 2021, the parties agree that the Commencement Date shall be delayed to such a date upon which TFS approval is secured and the Term revised accordingly.

Early Termination: No option to terminate early.

Option to Extend: No option to extend.

Permitted Use: For the purpose of allowing the City to operate a temporary shelter. The City may engage with a third party provider to operate the Premises. The Hotel is a 100% smoke free facility. Smoking is only permitted outside the building at the regulation distance. The City will enforce this policy.

City Obligations: The City will be responsible for security, biohazard waste disposal and related costs, and provision of blankets, linens, and mattress protectors for all the beds within the hotel during the term, and all costs related to preparing the building for the City's use including labour and materials. The City will be responsible for any damages to the Premises or additional costs incurred by the Landlord as a result of the City's occupancy of the Premises.

Landlord Obligations: Save and except for Fire, Life and Safety requirements, which are to be complied with by the Landlord at the Landlord's sole expense, the Premises will be provided in an "as-is" condition. The Landlord shall provide the City and its service providers with access to the Premises, on a 24/7 basis, for the duration of the Term. The Landlord will continue to manage the building with property management coverage at the front desk.

The Landlord shall be solely responsible for the operation and maintenance of core operation obligations and building systems within the Hotel, including the provision of the following:

- Electrical power for normal lighting used by the City and domestic hot and cold running water as required for the Permitted Use;
- Standard waste management services;
- Fire & life safety systems and related maintenance and monitoring;
- Elevator maintenance, repair, and replacement;
- Routine pest control services. Unusual services, such as bed bug recovery would be paid by City;
- Building envelope and capital repairs;
- HVAC system capabilities, limitations and maintenance activities on site;
- Access to internet and Wi-Fi for the City's staff, staff of the City's third party service provider, and clients
- Access to cable TV for clients;
- Custodial, housekeeping and laundry services, including weekly room cleaning, room cleaning within 12 hours upon client turnover and custodial/housekeeping services for all common areas and common washrooms in the Hotel; and
- All maintenance, cleaning and repairs required for the general upkeep of the Hotel, including without limitation, all landscaping, prompt removal of all debris, snow and ice removal, from all common areas and facilities of the Hotel, including exterior sidewalks adjacent to the Hotel.

**Additional Services:** the Landlord will provide catering services consisting of 3 meals and 2 snacks for an additional charge of \$30/day/occupant plus HST. To facilitate the delivery of the catering service, if required by the City, the Landlord shall enter into a catering service agreement with the City, on the City's standard form; a copy of which has been provided to and reviewed by the Landlord.

**Restoration of the Premises:** The City shall, within 30 days following the end of the Term, vacate the Premises, remove any property of any kind brought on the Premises by the City and return the Premises as close as is practicable, to its original condition immediately prior to the Commencement Date, including but not limited to full deep cleaning of the Premises, replacement of damaged FF&E and other damaged property. The City shall pay Rent on the basis of 205 rooms/day for the period of time required to complete the restoration of the Premises.

After the end of the Term, the City will determine the City's estimated cost to restore the Premises, and the City will have the option of restoring the Premises or paying out the Landlord the cost to restore the Premises in lieu of restoring the Premise, provided that in the latter case, the Landlord is agreeable to accepting the payout amount. In the event that the City wishes to make payment to the Landlord in lieu of restoring the Premises, the City will notify the Landlord of the City's estimated cost to restore the Premises, and the Landlord may elect to be paid out the amount of restoration obligations as per the City's estimate (the "**Restoration Costs**"), in lieu of the City fulfilling its restoration obligations pursuant to this Section. The Landlord will notify the City within two (2) business days of receipt of the Restoration Costs whether or not the Landlord elects to be paid out Restoration Costs. In the event that the Landlord fails to notify the City of the Landlord's election within the said two (2) business days, the Landlord's right to elect shall be null and void, and the City shall proceed to restore the Premises as set out in this Section. If the Landlord elects not to accept the Restoration Costs, the City shall be required to restore the Premises as set out in this Section. The City shall not be required to pay the applicable gross Rent for the period of time required to complete the restoration of the Premises during the said two (2) business day election period.

**Indemnification/Insurance:** The City will provide a \$10,000,000.00 for Commercial General Liability and \$1,000,000.00 for Automobile Liability. City will meet reasonable insurance requirements as established by the Landlord and the Landlord's insurer in the standard form of lease, subject to reasonable amendments as required by the City's Insurance Risk Management. The City agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Landlord from all loss, costs, damages, claims or demands for any act or negligence whatsoever with respect to the Tenant's use of the Premises, including, without limitation, illness of any occupants or employees of the City at the Premises and damage to any property of the Landlord (collectively the "Loss and Costs"), unless such Loss and Costs are caused by the negligence of the Landlord, or those for whom it is responsible at law.

**Pets:** The Landlord will give reasonable efforts to accommodate requests to allow pets in the Hotel to reside with the hotel occupants. Service animals shall be accepted.

**Other Provisions:** Provided that the physical distancing obligations are being maintained, while such requirements are legally required to be maintained, the City shall be permitted to place occupants into rooms in accordance with the Hotel's current approved fire safety plans and/or in accordance with the number of persons ordinarily permitted to occupy a room based on the type of room, as the case may be.

### New Physical Distancing Homelessness Services in your community

The building located at 45 The Esplanade, will open to serve clients in late February 2021. The site has been secured by the City of Toronto to act as an emergency support, temporary shelter as part of the three-tiered COVID-19 response. The hotel has been leased from the property owner until December 2021 with the potential for extension as public health guidance changes.

45 The Esplanade is one of more than 40 additional sites in 13 different wards opened across the city as part of the COVID-19 response to provide physical distancing within the shelter system. It is one of the more than 25 additional sites currently open. More information about the City's plan for homelessness services as part of the response to COVID-19 can be found at [www.toronto.ca/PhysicalDistancingShelters](http://www.toronto.ca/PhysicalDistancingShelters).

#### How will the community be engaged?

The City's engagement process for homelessness services focuses on facilitating active discussions between service operators, elected officials and the community on how to best support the success of a new shelter into the neighbourhood. New locations are determined by staff based on requirements specific to the needs of a shelter such as proximity to transit, affordability, and accessible infrastructure.

The community engagement process typically begins much earlier before the opening of a new service. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this has accelerated the pace of opening new, temporary sites. As a result, engagement activities will begin immediately prior to the service opening, and will continue to support a smooth transition.



### Support Programs at 45 The Esplanade

Homes First will deliver a program that offers wrap-around supports for the clients. Clients will be assigned a Counsellor/Case Manager who will work with them on developing a permanent housing plan. Other supports will include but not limited to:

- Daily meals
- Recreational programming
- Access to harm reduction supplies and supports to reduce potential harms related to substance use
- Mental and physical health related supports delivered by the Inner City Health Associates

### Addressing Community Concerns Proactively

Safety and security is a priority for the City. Ongoing safety planning will be a key component of the community engagement process. The operator of the site, Homes First, is working closely with Toronto Police Services, Shelter, Support and Housing Administration and Corporate Security at the City of Toronto to develop community safety measures for the location. Safety and security measures include a comprehensive safety plan with 24/7 foot patrols in the building and community and onsite cameras and security. Homes First will also bring management practices that have proven successful at its other locations. All Homes First staff are trained on de-escalation, conflict resolution and crisis prevention, intervention and management.

A key highlight to the community engagement process will be the formation of a **Community Liaison Committee (CLC)**, with membership and input from the existing CLC in the area. A CLC is a formal committee connected to a shelter service made up of representatives of the community (condo boards, residence associations, businesses or local community organizations) that meets semi-regularly to address questions, share information, discuss and collectively problem solve community concerns.

## **New temporary hotel shelter program at 45 The Esplanade for safe indoor accommodation during the pandemic**

Dear Neighbours,

I am writing to provide you with an update on the City of Toronto's efforts to stop the spread of COVID-19 in our community.

Public health experts know that disease preys on poverty, and COVID-19 is no different. The social determinants of health – income, education, and employment, along with gender, race, and Indigenous status, to name a few – shape who is healthy, who gets sick, and who dies. While we are asking everyone to practice physical distancing and to stay home as much as possible right now, we have to recognize the hard reality that you can't stay home if you don't have one. And many people experiencing homelessness live with underlying chronic medical conditions that further increase their risk from COVID-19.

We have a collective responsibility to support people experiencing homelessness. And the COVID-19 outbreak will never be brought under control until we step up and do all that is necessary to keep vulnerable members of our community safe, healthy, and housed.

The City of Toronto has been working around the clock to reduce transmission in our shelters, and ensure safe continuation of the services that serve people experiencing homelessness. More than 7,000 people access our shelter system every night, and more sleep outdoors. This work is informed by the goals of reducing spread, saving lives, and protecting our most vulnerable. The City of Toronto's response is being led by the Shelter, Support and Housing Administration (SSHA) Division, on the advice of Toronto Public Health, which has developed a three tier response focused on prevention, mitigation and recovery.

One of the critical strategies to prevent the spread of COVID-19 is to ensure that people experiencing homelessness and accessing the shelter system can practice physical distancing. In many conventional shelter facilities, beds and other activities are too close together to allow for safe physical distancing. As a result, the City of Toronto has been working to activate dozens of new facilities in order to spread out existing beds and services. Due to reduced capacity at existing shelters, there is still a net decrease in the number of overall shelter beds in the downtown, even with the current new temporary shelters.

### **45 The Esplanade temporary shelter hotel**

Following Public Health recommendations, in late February the hotel at 45 The Esplanade will begin to be used for temporary shelter program. The site has been leased until December 2021 as one of more than 40 additional sites across the city. At the same time, The City is reviewing related services in the local area as 45 The Esplanade opens. More information will be provided on this review as it becomes available.

The shelter program will be operated by Homes First, an organization with more than 35 years of experience caring for the most vulnerable members of our community.

The temporary shelter hotel will provide comprehensive, wrap-around support for its clients:

- A minimum of 12 Homes First staff will be available on-site to support clients 24/7, in addition to supervisors on each shift
- Special supervisors in Health Navigation and Living Standards will be a part of the program
- Clients will be assigned an Intensive Case Management Worker and a Housing Help Worker who will work with residents to develop a permanent housing plan and a plan to obtain personal documents, a local primary care physician, and employment
- All meals will be provided on-site
- Recreational and social engagement programming will be offered on-site
- The [Inner City Health Associates](#) and [Multi-Discipline Outreach Teams](#) will provide a number of mental and physical health related supports including nursing, a clinic with a primary care physician, and psychiatric support
- Physical, social and health supports from organizations serving people living in encampments will be invited to continue their work at 45 The Esplanade
- Harm reduction supports will be available on-site
- Controls for containing COVID-19 will include sanitation protocols for dining and elevators
- The above services will only be available for clients residing at the hotel shelter

Additional measures will be in place to stop the spread of COVID-19, including a standard screening process following public health guidelines at all points of entry. The City of Toronto has established procedures in place to ensure that anyone who needs to be tested for COVID-19 is quickly identified, receives transportation directly to a provincial Assessment Centre, and is housed at a dedicated isolation shelter until the test results are received. We also have dedicated recovery facilities in hotel settings with appropriate medical supports for people experiencing homelessness who test positive for COVID-19, but who do not require hospitalization. You can read more about the public health measures for the [45 Esplanade temporary shelter here](#).

I know that some neighbours may have questions about how the shelter hotel operates, and I am committed to working actively together with the community, the operator Homes First, and City of Toronto staff to address any issues that may be identified. Resources have been allocated to ensure that there is 24-hour staffing and security on site, as well as two 24/7 neighbourhood Community Safety Teams to circulate in the neighbourhood to address issues.

I also know that our community is, and always has been, a welcoming community. As we work to support those who are most vulnerable, we will also ensure that St. Lawrence remains a safe and vibrant neighbourhood.

### **Community Engagement**

The City is hosting a public information session with the community on February 18, from 7 to 9 pm. The link to the online session [will be available at this website](#) one day before the session is scheduled.

Following the public meeting, an ongoing Community Liaison Committee (CLC) will be formed made up of representatives of the community (condo boards, resident associations, businesses or local community organizations) that meets semi-regularly to address questions, share information, discuss and collectively problem solve community concerns.

### **Ending Chronic Homelessness**

Emergency responses alone cannot solve homelessness. The stark reality facing those without adequate homes in our city is a multi-year wait for supportive housing and years-long waiting list for

affordable housing, and skyrocketing market rents. As we all continue to work urgently to mitigate the crisis of COVID-19, it is also imperative that we turn our minds to the next big challenge: recovery.

Going back to the old status quo would leave us with the same risks, vulnerabilities, and failures as a society that have made the pandemic so difficult to weather. We need to tackle our housing crisis and end chronic homelessness.

With support from our government partners, it will be possible to leverage our emergency shelter response into a housing-first solution to homelessness. With capital funding to purchase underused buildings, and to quickly build new affordable housing units, we can help everyone to transition into safe, appropriate, affordable housing. With long-term operating funding for supportive housing, we can provide people with the resources and services they need to live healthy and happy lives.

This prescription is both bold and sensible. The bottom line for all governments is that permanent housing is cheaper in the long-run than if people experiencing homelessness are in shelters or hospital beds. I am advocating for the City of Toronto, Province of Ontario, and Government of Canada to work together to put public health first by ending chronic homelessness.

This effort has already made a difference. In the past months, the City has accelerated the 24-Month COVID-19 Housing and Homelessness Recovery Response Plan to provide 3000 new housing opportunities, through a combination of quick build modular homes, acquisition of properties, and portable Canada-Ontario Housing benefits. Financial support from the Federal Government through the Rapid Housing plan is helping to achieve these goals. I will continue to work with my Council colleagues, government partners, and our community to advance this work.
